Abusive language and unacceptable behaviour on the Club premises and courts is not allowed. Such behaviour will result in the offender being banned from club activities and in extreme cases or repeated incidents, their membership of the Club will be rescinded.

Members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have with Committee Members.

All Club Members should agree to

SAFE AND INCLUSIVE CODE OF CONDUCT

- Prioritise the well-being of all children and adults at all times
- Be a positive role model.
- Help to create a safe and inclusive environment both on and off court and promote the Fair Play values: enjoy; respect.
- Only use the floodlights in accordance with planning permission conditions, with switch-off times of 10pm.
- Keep to agreed timings for training and competitions, or inform their coach or team captain if they are going to be late.
- Wear suitable kit for training and match sessions.
- Pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Value and celebrate diversity
- Report any safeguarding concerns to the Welfare Officer (contact details on noticeboard or website) as soon as possible. **Doing nothing is NOT an option:**

The Code of Conduct should be interpreted in a spirit of integrity, transparency and common sense, with the best interests of children and adults at risk as the primary consideration.
